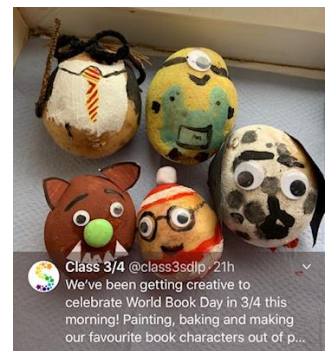


World Book Day – We loved celebrating our love of reading this week...
