Dear Parents, Carers and Guardians

I am writing to you after the announcement provided by the Prime Minister this evening at 8.00pm. the country will now go into a National Lockdown from Tuesday 5th January

Measures to be implemented in all Exceed Academies from Tuesday 5th January 2021

We have been notified by Doncaster Council and the Regional Schools Commissioner that we now have to move to remote learning immediately.

Our academies will be in contact tomorrow (Tuesday) morning with details of the remote learning provision. This will be undertaken on our Seesaw provision which we have already implemented. Each class teacher will liaise with pupils from 11.00am through the seesaw app and provide feedback for the learning. We will also be contacting all parents in order to collect / send out packs of resources which your child(ren) can use whilst learning remotely. If you do not have online provision, please contact the academy from 11.00am and we will set this up for you or provide you with some learning materials that your child (ren) can use for their remote learning.

Our academies will communicate with you the booking system for critical workers and vulnerable children as required by the Department for Education. We will send further details out about who will be able to access this provision from Wednesday 6th January 2021.

Thank you for your ongoing support and understanding during these difficult times. We will work together in order to ensure that the learning for your child (ren) continues.
