Weave-a-Bee

Create a weaving loom from a cardboard box by cutting out an oval shape and snipping small triangles around the edge. Then use yellow and black wool to wrap around your oval to create your bee! Finish it off with some eyes and wings.



Vocabulary: paint, pastel, chalk, pencil, finger print, Primary and secondary colours. Brush, palette, water pot, dip, mix, scrape, join, print, thick, thin, straight, wavy, lines, dab, circular. Patterns, shapes, long, short lines, curved, colour fill, fold, symmetry.



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
