Mathematics and English:

In mathematics, children are focusing on
place value - really understanding the value
of numbers and how these link to other
numbers. Children in Year 1 focus on
numbers to 20 in the Autumn term, and Y2
children focus to 100. Once we have
secured this understanding we progress
onto addition and subtraction. Year 1
children will use concrete objects and
number lines whereas year 2 children begin
to secure the column method.

In English children across both year groups
will be developing their letter formation
and securing basic punctuation.
